Dr. Chen is currently Director at the Sexual Dysfunction Clinic and Senior Urologist in the Department of Urology at the Tel-Aviv Sourasky Medical Center. He is also Full Associated Professor of Urology at Tel-Aviv Sourasky Medical Center and Sackler Faculty of Medicine, Tel-Aviv University.

He is an active member in the field of sexual medicine. In addition to 75 published articles, 2 books and 3 chapters on the subject, he has also been involved in many professional societies. He served on the Executive Committee of the European Society for Sexual Medicine, as President of the Israeli Society for Sexual Medicine and as chair of the ISSWSH Membership Committee. Recently Dr Chen was elected as member of the directors at large of the ISSWSH. He is member of the educational and prize committees of the International Society for Sexual Medicine. Since 2006 Dr. Chen is member of the Editorial board of the Journal of Sexual Medicine – the official journal of the ISSM and ESSM. He serves as reviewer by invitation for the

Journal of Urology, European Urology, JSM, IJIR, and Journal of Infectious Disease.

Dr. Chen received his medical degree from the University of Naltchic FRSSR in the USSR, and did his residency in General and Vascular Surgery as well as his residency in Urology at the Ichilov Hospital, Tel-Aviv Sourasky Medical Center. He completed his fellowship in Urology at the Medical College of Virginia in Richmond, Virginia and fellowship in Sexual Medicine at the McGuire Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Richmond, Virginia. He was also a visiting attending at the Institute of Urology and Nephrology at the University College of London, Lister & Middlesex Hospitals in London, England and at the Elisabethinen Hospital, Linz, Austria.

Dr. John Dean is a Sexual Physician, and practices in London and South Devon, both privately and within the UK National Health Service. Having originally trained as a Family Physician, he has provided psychosexual and biomedical care for men and women affected by

sexual problems since 1985. He also provides the UK National Health Service regional service in the South-West of England for people affected by gender identity disorders. He is an active clinical researcher and author, and has a special interest in the effects of prostate cancer on sexuality, chronic prostatitis, women's sexual health, desire disorders and ethical considerations in sexual medicine.

Dr. Dean is President-Elect of the International Society for Sexual Medicine, Secretary-General of the European Society for Sexual Medicine, a member of the International Society for the Study of Women's Sexual Health and the European Association of Urology, an associate member of the British Association of Urological Surgeons, and a general member of the British Association for Sexual and Relationship Therapy. He has published around sixty papers, and authored or contributed to four books, on Sexual Medicine subjects. He is chairman of the ethics committees of the Journal of Sexual Medicine and the International Society for the Study of Women's Sexual Health.

Dr. Dean trained at The Middlesex Hospital Medical School, London, qualifying MB BS in 1981, and MRCP in 1986. He was elected a Fellow of the Royal College of General Practitioners in 1999.



Andrea Salonia, MD (Italia)

Andrea Salonia, MD, is a full staff urologist at the Department of Urology of the Scientific Institute H. San Raffaele in Milan, Italy. Dr. Salonia received his medical degree from the University of the Milan School of Medicine and he completed his residency in urology at the University of Trieste, in Trieste, Italy.

Dr. Salonia's major research interests have included several urological areas with a specific focus on pathophysiology, diagnosis and management of male and female sexual dysfunctions, neuro-urology and urodynamics, bladder and prostate cancer.

Dr. Salonia has written and coauthored over 80 peer reviewed journal articles and some book chapters. His most recent contributions to the field of Urology and Sexual Medicine have been on the clinical and surgical aspect of the prostate cancer, and on the pathophysiology of ED and FSD.

He is an official reviewer for European Journal of Obstetrics & Gynecology and Reproductive Biology, European Urology, The Asian Journal of Andrology, The International Journal of Andrology, The International Journal of Impotence Research, The International Journal of Obesity, The Journal of Sexual Medicine, and The Journal of Urology.

Dr. Salonia held positions in the scientific committee of the European Society for Sexual Medicine, of the International Society for the Study of Women's Sexual Health and the Italian Society of Andrology and was the winner of the Excellence Award 2006 of the European Society for Sexual Medicine.
